# YEAR OF REVIEW OF THE OPENING OF THE DRUMMOND MUSEUM

The Drummond Museum was reopened with regular hours in May. It was a very good year, and we want to thank the community for all your support. The museum's annual budget is \$3,000.00, that is the amount needed to pay the bills and keep the doors open and free admission. We received \$3,000.00 in grants this year and a little over \$2,500.00 in community donations. We had the museum building put on the National Register or Historic Places in early spring 2024.

We have had visitors from as far away as Massachusetts, California and Virgina!

Our permanent exhibits include Little Nick, The Circus, Churches and Home. The special exhibit we were able to run this year was a Veterans exhibit. Many thanks to George Throckmorton, Larry Thompson, Randy McWilliams, Bryan Sherbourne, Leon Miller and Kenny Miller for their museum loans. Thank you also to the Ott's, Christenson's, Henneke's, Shreves, and the family of Charles Allen for their

Fourth, Fifth, and Sixth grade social studies classes taught my Kim Arnold visited the Veterans Exhibits. They were excellent students with great questions!

The Museum's recently repaired roof was damaged again by the May hailstorm. It was so badly damaged that we needed an entirely new roof. Eagle Heritage from Enid put our new roof on in October.

We hope to add two more permanent exhibits this year. We are working with the Enid Railroad Museum to design and create a model train that would resemble the earliest train in Drummond. We also hope to get the bank exhibit complete with some original cages. The original material was made possible by donation from Terry Vaughn.

Upcoming exhibits include a photography exhibit "Enduring Spirit" from photographer Simone Mattea from Drummond. The exhibit will be available in January and February. There will be a presentation on the exhibit on Saturday January 25<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 and another one Sunday January 26<sup>th</sup> at 2:00. Also, the 6<sup>th</sup> grade social studies

classes will be preparing some presentations on Drummond History. The dates have not been set yet.
