Storm Water Drainage Improvements REAP GRANT

At the last council meeting, the city council approved Jason Brinley Engineering's contract. Jason said that we can expect in the next 30-40 days that we will start surveying Oklahoma Street. I will keep everyone posted on the project.

OG&E Franchise agreement renewal for the next 25 years

At the February 20th Special meeting the city council granted that we take it to a Townwide election pertaining to

granting of a franchise to the Oklahoma gas and Electric company for the use of streets, alleys, and public places within the Town of Drummond for the production, transmission, distribution, and sale of electric current.

The resolution was introduced calling for a special election in the Town of Drummond for the purpose of submitting to qualified electors of the Town of Drummond the question of whether an ordinance granting a franchise to Oklahoma Gas and electric company should be approved by a majority of the voters, authorizing the mayor to call the election by proclamation and requesting the County election board to conduct the election.

The election will take place on the 13th day of May 2025 between the hours of 7:00 am and 7:00 pm. Make sure you get out to vote. And vote YES!!!!
