Enid Water Shut off

The Enid Water Project has notified the Town of Drummond that we will lose water from them on Monday August 3rd. During this time, we will hook on to Bison Rural Water as we have announced beforehand. We will continue to use Bison Rural Water till what they predict to be late October. During this time, just a reminder to our customers that the water rates will be increased during the active use with Bison Rural Water. As soon as Enid is ready to connect us back, we will connect back and the water rates will go back down to normal.
