MUSEUM NEWS

The Drummond Museum has a "Wildlife of the Drummond Flats" exhibit which will run through July. We have taxidermied animals on display that are native to Drummond flats. We have bobcats, porcupine, red fox, coyote, wild turkey, pheasant, white tailed deer, beaver and many species of birds including a rail and rare

duck. The animals have been provided by Chase Kokojan and Bill Yirka, both wildlife specialists.
